You will require a willingness to learn new technologies and work responsively in a team environment. We will provide training, support and mentorship to develop and grow your skills. You must be able to participate in the on-call, out-of-hours technical response team and be willing to travel domestically and overseas.

- Experience supporting network systems using hardware such as Cisco routers, switches and firewalls.
- Experience supporting unified Voice and Video systems using Cisco technologies
- Experience in system monitoring, performance optimisation and process improvements.

- WAN acceleration, ideally using Riverbed equipment.
- Exposure to networks using commercial and government grade cryptographic equipment.
